Donut /Kamps Ride - 11 Miles

9:04 AM Year-round Starts at Tennis Center parking lot at Will Rogers Park (near NW 39th and Portland). Goes to Brown's Bakery at NW 10th and Walker, or Kamps-1910 at 10 NE 10th. Suitable for all levels of riders and family groups.

No-Drop (the ride leader stays with the slowest rider).

Weekday Leisure Ride - 10 Mi.


9:00 AM Mon, Tue, Thu & Fri (Year Round)

Sunday Morning Bricktown Ride—24 Mi.


8:30 AM Year-round
